




Modern Air Plants

Knitted Air Plant Displays



YARN

Bulky
Wool
Any color

NEEDLES

U.S. size 7 (mm)
double-pointed needles
set of four

NOTIONS

Stitch marker
Scissors
Yarn Needle

GAUGE

None

SEED POD

Cast on 3 sts and work back and forth without turning needle for 1 inch. (Creates short i-cord.)

Rnd 1: (kfb) repeat to end of row (6 sts total).

Divide sts between 3 needles to begin working in the round. Use care not to twist sts.

Rnd 2: knit.

Rnd 3: (k1, kfb) repeat to end of round (3 sts/needle, 9 total)

Rnd 4: knit

Rnd 5: (kfb, k1, kfb) repeat to the end of the round (5 sts/needle, 15 sts total).

Rnd 6: knit

Rnd 7: (kfb, k3, kfb) repeat to the end of the round (7 sts/needle, 21 sts total).

Rnd 8: knit

Rnd 9: (kfb, k5, kfb), repeat to the end of the round (9 sts/27 sts total).

Rnd 10: knit

Begin stockinette. Work back and forth: purl row, knit row, slipping 1st stitch of every row purlwise ending on a knit row. Knit for several inches if you would like a large opening, or, for a small opening only knit in stockinette for a few rows.

Resume working in the round, decreasing.

Rnd 1: (k1, k2tog), repeat to the end of the round





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SEED POD

continued

(6 sts/ needle).

Rnd 2 and 3: knit

Rnd 4: k1, k2tog Rnd 5 and 6: knit

Rnd 7: K2tog, repeat to the end of the round (2 sts/ needle, 6 total sts).

Rnd 8: Knit.

Rnd 9: k2tog, 3 times Work in i-cord to desired length.

K 3 together. Cut yarn and thread needle end through remaining st.



I-CORD

Cast on 3 stitches, work back and forth with out turning the needle. Knit to desired length. Knit 3 tog. Cut yarn and slip yarn through remaining loop and weave in end.

To make the cord thicker or slimmer use a heavier or lighter weight yarn and cast on more or fewer stitches.
